## Bring to the ARRL Exam Session:

- ✓ Your Federal Registration Number (FRN) allocated during the FCC registration process; <a href="https://wireless.fcc.gov/uls">https://wireless.fcc.gov/uls</a>
- ✓ A legal photo ID (Passport, Identity Card, Driver's License)
- √ The exam fee (cash only): US-\$ 15.00 (or CHF 16.00 / EUR 15.00)
- ✓ A valid US postal address. Can also be the c/o address of a friend or a rental P.O. Box.
- ✓ Bring either a photocopy of your current US Amateur Radio license or a reference copy printed out from the FCC website <u>and</u> a photocopy(s) of any Certificates of Successful Completion of Examination (CSCE). The photocopy(s) will not be returned
- ✓ Pencil, eraser and a pen

..... ready to take the exam(s)?

- ✓ A calculator with the memory erased and formulas cleared is allowed.
- ✓ Written notes or calculations are NOT allowed

## **Examination procedure and other information**

- Walk-ins allowed (no pre-registration required)
- There are no special admission requirements (age, health, nationality or residence)
- US licenses are good for 10 years before renewal and anyone may hold one except a representative of a foreign government
- To upgrade to General Class {Extra Class}, you must already hold a Technician Class {General Class} license or have recently passed the Technician {General} license exam.
- A candidate pays one test fee and is entitled to take tests for Elements 2, 3 and 4 as needed, up to all three under the single test fee. If an examinee *retakes* a failed exam element, he/she has to pay a second test fee.

The <u>NCVEC Quick-Form 605 Application</u> must be filled out at the beginning or brought with you to the exam (recommended).
